Isaiah 42:1-4

¹ "Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles. ² He will not cry out, nor raise *His voice*, Nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. ³ A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax He will not quench; He will bring forth justice for truth. ⁴ He will not fail nor be discouraged, Till He has established justice in the earth; And the coastlands shall wait for His law."

SCHOLARLY IMAGINATION

Response

- New Testament writers attest to unity of Isaiah
- Book found a unity at Qumran
- The longer the book the greater the stylistic shift
- Isaiah autographed with:

'Qadosh Israel'—"Holy One of Israel"

- > 12 times in chapters 1-39
- > 13 times in rest of book
- God knew about Cyrus

Sing a New Song

Isaiah 42:10-13

Let the wilderness and its cities lift up *their voice*, The villages *that* Kedar inhabits.

Let the inhabitants of Sela sing, Let them shout from the top of the mountains. 12 Let them give glory to the Lord, And declare His praise in the coastlands.

¹³ The Lord shall go forth like a mighty man; He shall stir up *His* zeal like a man of war. He shall cry out, yes, shout aloud; He shall prevail against His enemies.


