## *Zion and the Gentiles* *Isaiah 62:1-3*

- 1** For Zion's sake I will not hold My peace,

- 2** The Gentiles shall see your righteousness,  
And all kings your glory.  
You shall be called by a new name,

- 3** You shall also be a crown of glory  
In the hand of the LORD,  
And a royal diadem  
In the hand of your God.

or come to mind.



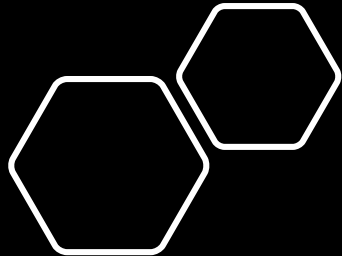












# *Millennial Conditions*
