## *Isaiah 8:1-4*

### **Assyria Will Invade the Land**

- 1** Moreover the LORD said to me, “Take a large scroll, and write on it with a man’s pen concerning Maher-Shalal-Hash-Baz.
- 2** And I will take for Myself faithful witnesses to record, Uriah the priest and Zechariah the son of Jeberechiah.”
- 3** Then I went to the prophetess, and she conceived and bore a son. Then the LORD said to me, “Call his name Maher-Shalal-Hash-Baz;
- 4** for before the child shall have knowledge to cry ‘My father’ and ‘My mother,’ the riches of Damascus and the spoil of Samaria will be taken away before the king of Assyria.”



<sup>19</sup> And when they say to you, “Seek those who are mediums and wizards, who whisper and mutter,” should not a people seek their God? *Should they seek the dead on behalf of the living?*

<sup>20</sup> To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, *it is because there is no light in them.*

By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, In Galilee of the  
Gentiles.
- <sup>2</sup> The people who walked in darkness Have seen a great  
light; Those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of  
death, Upon them a light has shined.
- <sup>3</sup> You have multiplied the nation And increased its joy; They  
rejoice before You According to the joy of  
harvest, As men rejoice when they divide the spoil.

And the government will be upon His shoulder.

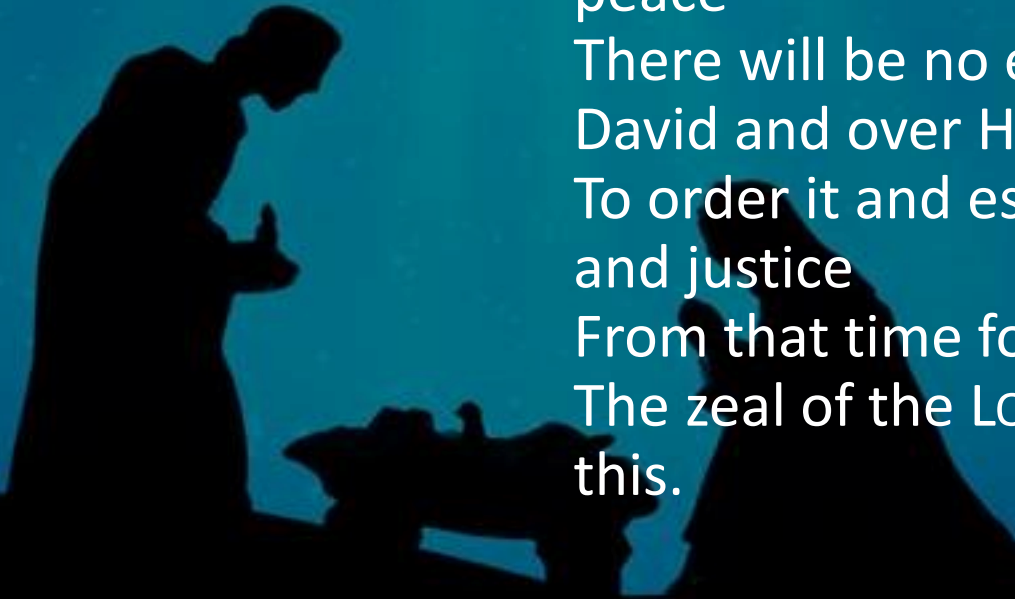
And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
