



### The Dead Church

3 And to the angel of the church in Sardis write, 'These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead.



- The Church at Sardis
- The seven Spirits of God
- The One who holds the Seven Stars
- A name of Life, but you are dead

# Sordid History of Sardis

A place of Jewish exile

#### **Obadiah 20**

And the captives of this host of the children of Israel Shall possess the land of the Canaanites
As far as Zarephath.
The captives of Jerusalem who are in Sepharad Shall possess the cities of the South.

- Sepharad references to Lud and Ludim in:
  - Genesis 10
  - 1 Chronicles 1 Lydia
- Gold discovered in Pactolus River, tributary of Hermus Midas, king of Phrygia Herodotus and Strabo

- After 700
   B.C. Gyges, first king of Mermnedine – (also, Gugu)
- Croesus threatened by Persians. Delphic Oracle said, "If you will cross the Halys, you will destroy a great Empire."
- Sardian soldiers' mistake— the city Falls.
- ❖ Again in 214 B.C.
- Tragic earthquake of AD 17, told by Pliny and Tacitus

<sup>3</sup>Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.

#### **Remnant in Sardis**



- <sup>4</sup> You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white, for they are worthy.
- <sup>5</sup> He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.
- <sup>6</sup> "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." '

- ➤ The few undefiled
- They walk in purity before Christ
